



A. A continuing quality improvement programme to improve quality of teaching staff in both parties.



ARTICLE III

Courses: Seminars, Workshops, Refresher Courses

It is agreed that CEC will arrange periodic seminars, workshops and refresher courses in collaboration with CEMS. 
